As we welcome 2023, we look back at what 2022 has in store when you file your 2022 tax returns. The President and Congress could not agree on an extension of the tax extender bill. Numerous tax credits have expired and reverted to pre Covid tax law. Most notable is the reduction in the Child Tax Credit (CTC). The CTC drops back to \$2000 credit per child, from the \$3000 to \$3600, respectively. Another tax credit, the Day Care Credit reverts to a credit of \$1050 to \$ 2100, from \$4000 to \$8000, respectively. Many of you are seeing lower federal withholding from your paychecks. This is due to the new W4 Federal tax withholding tables. This change can also affect tax refunds or even balance due returns. New reporting requirements for self-employed individuals, gig economy. The IRS is requiring payors to issue 1099K for income of \$600 or more earned from casual sales of goods or services.

We are continuing to accept drop off returns in person and through our contactless drop box, as well as mail, fax, and email returns. We ask that you limit the number of people that accompany you to a maximum of 2 individuals per visit.

Unemployment

If you collected unemployment, you **must** obtain a 1099 online or directly from an unemployment office.

NJ Department of Labor will not mail them.

Standard Mileage Rates

The standard mileage rate for the cost of operating your car is **58.5** cents per mile from 1/1 to 06/30 and **62.5** cents per mile from 7/1 to 12/31. Please provide us with two figures. The standard mileage rate allowed for use of your car for medical reasons is **.18** cents per mile and charitable **.14** cents per mile.

Education Credits - YOU MUST HAVE FORM 1098T TO FILE FOR THE TAX DEDUCTION.

The American Opportunity Credit is **\$2,500** per eligible student available for first 4 years of college. The maximum Lifetime Learning Credit remains \$2,000 per eligible student. The Educator expense "teachers" deduction for \$300 is still in effect.

Restrictions on Charitable Contributions

Cash Contributions. All cash contributions made to any qualified charity must be supported by **A DATED BANK RECORD OR A DATED RECEIPT**. **Clothing and household items, NO** deduction is allowed for most contributions of clothing and household items unless the donated property is in good used condition or better and have a statement from the organization.

Homeowners – New Purchase or Refinance

If you purchased, sold, or refinanced your home this year, we will need you to bring a copy of your **(HUD) Uniform Settlement statement** provided to you. You may have more than one mortgage statement if your mortgage was sold, refinanced, or transferred to a new mortgage company; some home equity loan interest may not be deductible.

Self Employed Schedule C Income

IRS due diligence guidelines require you to provide me with a detailed written breakdown of all your income and expenses. **You must have written records of your business expenses, including invoices and receipts.**

Real Estate Tax Rebates

If you received a Property Tax Reimbursement check, these rebates are reportable and must be included on your tax return, please record the amount received since the state will not send out documentation.

Day Care Credit

To take the credit you must provide me with the provider's name, address, and SOCIAL SECURITY # or TAX ID #. Without the number, you are unable to take the credit. I suggest that you get a written statement.

Moved Out of State?

If you have moved out of state, we can still handle your tax return. We have the ability to process any state return. You can mail, fax, or e-mail your tax return information to us and best of all: we can E-file all your returns.

Direct Deposit

Get your refund **FASTER** with **DIRECT DEPOSIT**. If you would like to take advantage of this, please bring a **VOIDED** check with you. This is the safest - fastest method!!!

Payments

Due to increased credit/debit card processing fees, we will be adding a 4% surcharge on all credit/debit charges.

Where's my Refund?

Track the status of your refund at www.irs.gov and clicking on the **Where's my refund?** icon.

Enclosed you will find the customary questionnaire that will assist you in compiling your tax records. **Please complete the questionnaire and bring it with you when you have your tax appointment. This will eliminate any errors and expedite the preparation of your tax returns.**

PLEASE SIGN AND BRING BACK THE ENCLOSED FORM 8879 SO THAT WE MAY PROCESS THE ELECTRONIC FILING OF YOUR RETURN. (Form 8879 is on the back of your Income Tax Checklist)
